

# Teachers Training

**Place: Kachhwa**

**Date:18-01-2019 to 19-1-2019**

Teachers training was conducted at Kachhwa for the teachers of Bhadhohi, Mirzapur, Majhwa & Chandauli villages. A total of **Seventy-Eight** teachers attended the training.

Spiritual training was conducted by Mr. Renil Dasan and Educational training was conducted by Mrs. Neelima, assisted by Mrs. Kasia Thankachan and Mr. Santhosh Kumar.

## Training Highlights

We divided the teachers into two batches as follows:

Batch I - Majhwa and Bhadohi

Batch II - Mirzapur and Chandauli

Sessions were conducted for spiritual and educational training simultaneously to the two batches.

Training started with a prayer, short story & presentation of the potter and the clay.



A test was conducted to assess the teachers' progress which is proportional to students' learning. Teachers were able to inspect their own progress through this test and were trying to improve by correcting their mistakes.



The following topics were taught:

Teachers were taught how to prepare teaching aids and also to teach students using these aids.




Teachers were jubilant while presenting their projects.

**Observations from the test:**

- ❖ A teacher who didn't know the spelling of a word, tried to formulate that word using phonetics.
- ❖ Some teachers were not able to comprehend the questions.
- ❖ Some teachers knew the answer but did not know how to write the answer in English.

It was a blessing and great encouragement to see the zeal and enthusiasm of the teachers. Their eagerness to learn made them request for more learning. So, we decided to extend the training duration to **three** days with One day dedicated entirely to English learning.
